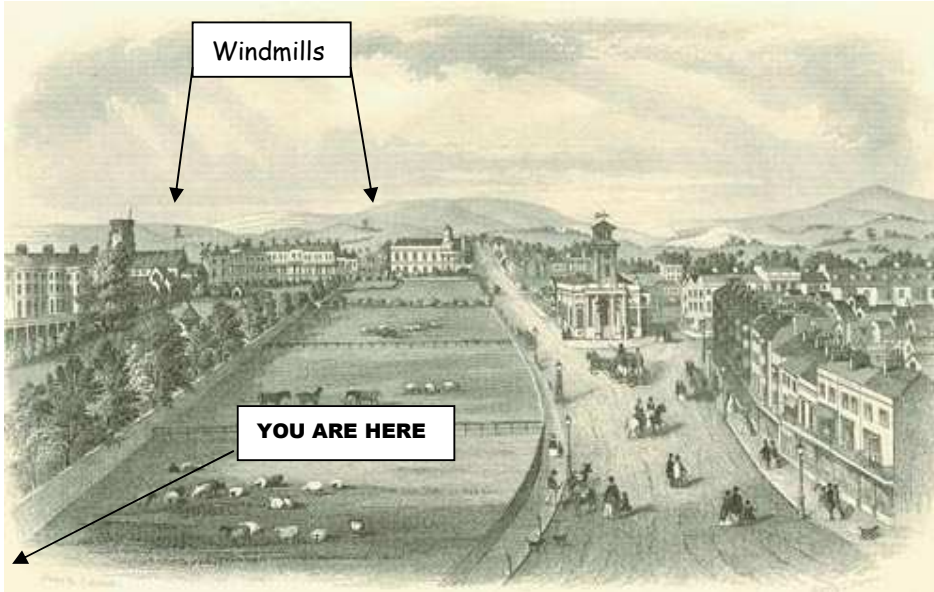


TOWN WALK
